- Possess a valid Driver's Licence
- Pass a Child Welfare Check
- Obtain an Enhanced RCMP Security Clearance
- Sign a Confidentiality Agreement
- Pass on-line Solicitor General Training
- Able to commit to a one-year term
- Able to provide support during daytime working hours

On Call Crisis Support

Advocates provide support to victims of crime and/or tragedy on an On-Call basis, after work hours and weekends.

Requirements:

- Live within 30 minutes of RCMP Detachment
- +18
- Possess a valid Driver's Licence
- Pass a Child Welfare Check
- Obtain an Enhanced RCMP Security Clearance
- Sign a Confidentiality Agreement
- Pass on-line Solicitor General Training
- Able to commit to a one-year term
- Able to commit to a minimum of four shifts per month (evenings, and/or weekends)
